

	Acorn	Yorkshire Pride	Bitter	3.7	This is a very pale session bitter, well hopped with Northdown and Cascade hops. 3rd place in Bitter Category at Sheffield Beer Festival 2008.
	Adnams	Bitter	Bitter	3.7	Fragrant aromas of finest English hops and malt. Dry but refreshing, with a distinctive lingering hoppiness. Appetising and delicious.
	Arundel	Stronghold	Bitter	4.7	A smooth full-flavoured premium bitter. A good balance of malt, fruit and hops comes through in this rich brew.
	Arundel	Sussex Mild	Mild	3.7	A traditional English style dark and smooth mild.

	Bateman's	XXXB	Bitter	4.8	A brilliant blend of malt, hops and fruit on the nose with a bitter bite over the top of a faintly banana maltiness that stays the course. A russet-tan brown classic.
	Bath Ales	Gem Bitter	Bitter	4.1	Well-balanced and complex, this medium-bodied bitter is malty, fruity and hoppy throughout. Amber-coloured, it is drier and more bitter at the end.
	Bath Ales	Spa	Bitter	3.7	This brew uses pale lager malt which gives it a wonderful golden hue. This is complemented by using a dwarf variety hop (First Gold) which imparts a prodominantly citrus aroma. It is dry without harshness, crisp and full flavoured, a hugely refreshing bitter.

	Bishop Nick Brewery	Compasses Bitter	Bitter	3.9	A brewery so new, nobody knows quite what this will be.
	Black Sheep	Black Sheep Special	Bitter	4.4	A well rounded and warming bitter beer with a good helping of hops and fruit in the taste and aroma, leading to a moderately dry, bitter aftertaste.
	Blackawton	West Country Gold	Bitter	4.1	A light golden fresh tasting ale bursting with sweet malt flavours and the delicate vanilla and fruit hints of the Styrian Golding hops.
	Blue Monkey	99 Red Baboons	Mild/Porter	4.2	An unusual combination of fruity hoppyness with a dark, malty side. This beer is distinctly difficult to categorise – is it sort of a porter or maybe a mild? You decide!
	Blue Monkey	BG Sips	Golden	4.0	A pale and intensely hoppy beer. Enticing tropical fruit aromas, finished with a good level of thirst quenching, almost peppery bitterness.

	Farmers Ales	A Drop of Nelson's Blood	Bitter	3.8	An easy drinking but flavourful bitter brewed for Trafalgar Day October 21st. After the battle, Nelson's body was returned to England preserved in a barrel of brandy. It is said that the sailors on the Victory drank some of the brandy as part of their grog ration, which became known as Nelson's Blood. Every glass contains a drop of brandy.
	Farmers Ales	Captain Ann	Bitter	4.5	A traditional premium bitter with malt notes from Maris Otter, Crystal and Chocolate Malt and lightly hopped with good old fashioned Fuggles and Goldings.
	Farmers Ales	Dark Horse	Bitter	6.6	A lovely chesnut at a powerful 6.6%. Using Golding hops so the beer is smooth on the palate but there is fire and spice in the finish like a fine maly whisky.
	Farmers Ales	Golden Boar	Strong	5.0	FGB is an amber beer with a tremendous aroma that will knock you socks off. We use an obscene amount of Cascade Hops to get the aroma. It's expensive to make but we just love it! It was originally brewed for the Pig's Ear Beer Festival last year, but it is still popular so we are still brewing it regularly.
